



## 2023 Senior Club Championship Rules *sponsored by* L&A Mutual Insurance Co. & Mark Riley

**Tee-Markers:** Senior Club Championship will be played from the WHITE tees.

**Local Rule:** If a player loses a ball, then they can choose to replay the shot with 1 penalty stroke incurred or can drop the ball 2 club lengths from the point of entry with 2 stroke penalty.

*Example: Player loses a ball after his tee shot goes down right side of Hole 1. They drop 2 club lengths from point of entry and play their 4<sup>th</sup> shot into the green.*

**Bunkers:** We will play the bunkers as lift, rake, and place.

### **Golf Course Staking & Ground Under Repair & Maintenance Areas:**

→ Lateral Penalty Areas are defined by RED stakes

→ Ponds/Water is defined by YELLOW stakes

→ Out of Bounds is defined by WHITE stakes

→ Ground Under Repair/Maintenance Area are defined by ORANGE stakes\*

*\*\*A player is entitled to free relief if they hit a ball into the Ground Under Repair area right of holes 1, 2 & 7.*

*\*\*\*A PLAYER MUST FIND THEIR BALL IN THE GROUND UNDER REPAIR **OR** THE WHOLE GROUP MUST AGREE THAT THE BALL CAME TO REST IN THE GROUND UNDER REPAIR on holes 1, 2 & 7 to be entitled to **FREE** relief. Drop areas will be available for players to drop at both Ground Under Repair locations.*

### **Electrical Standards on Hole 18:**

→ A player who hits a shot that strikes the electrical standards on hole 18 must replay the shot from the original position with no penalty.

→ A player is entitled to line and sight relief from the electrical standards on 18 if they are going to interfere with a shot into the green.

**Rule 3.3: Playing Two Balls When Uncertain What To Do** – A player who is uncertain about the right procedure while playing a hole may complete the hole with two balls without penalty. Please announce if Rule 3.3 has been used during play when signing your scorecard at the end of your round.

**Playing Rules:** Modified SUMMER Rules. Modified Summer Rules will mean that you can only roll your ball within 6 inches of its original position in your own fairway.

**Dry, Cracked or Unplayable Conditions:** FREE relief will be provided for any ball finishing in a dried & cracked surface in any location on the golf course. ***MUST BE AGREED UPON BY ALL MEMBERS OF THE GROUP.***
